Elk Neck State Park, Northeast, Maryland

Elk Neck is this year's CWP destination to connect with the vast landscapes and waters of the Chesapeake Bay. The park boasts 2,188 acres of sandy beaches, marshlands, and heavily wooded bluffs overlooking the North East River, the Elk River and the Chesapeake Bay.

PFM has reserved a group tenting site for PFM members and friends. The site is capable of holding 100 campers. The cost for the site reservation is FREE to PFM Member families and \$20 for non-member families [applicable to your membership fee if you join PFM at time of reservation]. There is a State Park service charge of \$4 per camper, payable at the entrance to the park.

There is a \$10 fully refundable deposit required with your reservation for PFM member families. The deposit will be returned at the campsite. Cancellation after August 5th 2011 will constitute forfeiture of the \$10 deposit or non-member \$20 reservation fee.

The park offers hiking, beach swimming, fishing, crabbing, canoeing, birding, modern toilet and shower facilities and a general store.
